The abstract should contain a cover letter and one-page (A4-size) abstract.

The cover letter should clearly state

- Title of paper
- Name, mailing address, email address, telephone and fax numbers of the presenting author
- Names and affiliations of additional authors
- Person to whom correspondence should be sent, if other than the presenting author
- Suggested topical area for the paper
- Preference for oral or poster presentation

One-page abstract should include

- Title of paper
- Names and affiliations of all authors
- No more than 300 words with one or two figures
