## M. Tech. Seminar [B.Tech - M.Tech (Cat-A) Dual Degree Students]

The department will offer two seminar courses, CE697A: M. Tech Seminar I and CE698A: M. Tech Seminar II starting 2017-18 1st Semester. The LTPD details for these courses shall be 0-0-0-0 [0].

Both the courses will be offered every semester (not in summer-term) from 2017-18 1<sup>st</sup> Semester onwards. Slots will be specified in the departmental time table for each seminar course.

CE697A is a pre-requisite for registering in CE698A. Category-A Dual Degree students have to clear both CE697A and CE698A before submission of M. Tech thesis.

Category-A Dual Degree students should normally register for CE697A in the  $9^{th}$  semester of their program and for CE698A in the  $10^{th}$  semester of their program.

Each Category-A Dual Degree student registered for the seminar course in a semester will give a 20 – 30 minute talk based on his/her research work. In addition, they will be expected to attend all seminars in their specialization.

Grading (S/X) shall be based on attendance and quality of the seminar presented by the student.

The schedule of seminars will be finalized in consultation with the registered students and their thesis supervisors and will notified at the beginning of the semester.

When a student gives a seminar, all students registered in that seminar course and the thesis supervisor(s) of the concerned student will be required to be present. Other faculty members and Ph.D students in related specializations are also expected to attend the seminar.

The DPGC convener will be the nominal instructor for both the seminar courses. However, grades will be given by the thesis supervisor(s) of the concerned student.
