

Sub: Visit of Indian Youth Delegation to various countries during 2018 - reg.

Sir,

I would like to inform you that under the International Youth Exchange Programme conducted by this Department, youth delegations are exchanged with various countries, to promote mutual understanding of values and culture among the youth and to develop better relations.

2. For the youth delegations to be sent to different countries this year, you are requested to forward around 120 nominations (60 males and 60 females, not exceeding 6 from each IITs) amongst the Meritorious Students from your Institution/Department in the order of priority/preference. The students nominated must be in the 2nd or 3rd year of their courses. Following points may be taken care of while forwarding the nominations:

- The proposed youth must be an Indian Citizen.
- The age of nominated delegates should not be more than 29 years.
- The nominated youth should be the regular student/volunteer/artist of your organization with excellent track record.
- The proposed youth should not have been sent abroad in any of the International Youth Exchange Programme organized by this Ministry before.
- The Youth should have no past history of criminal conviction and no criminal case must be pending against him/her in any court of law.
- The nominated youth must possess a valid Indian passport as on date of forwarding of nomination with expiry date on or after 30/06/2019 on the date of forwarding of nomination.
- The nominated youth must possess a valid Aadhar number or Aadhar registration number.

3. The nominations, duly filled in by each participant with a recent coloured passport size photograph (in white background), must be forwarded in the enclosed PROFORMA by 16th February, 2018. A brief description in approximately hundred words about the exceptional qualities and future utility of the nominee may also be forwarded along with the application form through email as well as through post. Applications received after 16th February, 2018 in the Ministry will not be considered.

4. Forwarding of nominations do not entail selection. A nomination received with incomplete information would summarily be rejected. The Ministry holds sole discretion in further selection of candidates/ delegates. Students and Institutes are also advised not to use other channels for follow up/influence/feedback etc.
